

## MARAM Pillars, Responsibilities and Principles

- 4 Pillars,
- 10 Responsibilities and
- 10 guiding Principles

provide the basis for the MARAM<sup>1</sup> Framework.

**The four Pillars:** Each of the Pillars contains a guiding concept, which is sometimes called a “framework requirement”. Leaders of organisations must align their policies, procedures, practice guidance and tools to these concepts.

**The ten Responsibilities** sit under Pillar 3 and clarify the actions each worker in an organisation is now responsible for.

**The ten Principles** are aimed at providing workers and services with a shared understanding of family violence, and facilitating consistent, effective and safe responses for people experiencing family violence. The principles recognise the right of all people to live free from family violence.
